Access

All **accredited journalists** can access IFAD HQ in Rome through the main entrance **on Via Paolo Di Dono 44, Roma 00100** between 7:30-1900 hours on Tuesday 13 February. Entry will be allowed **one hour prior** to the start of the opening session to ensure that media outlets with equipment will have time to set up in the Plenary Hall. Please arrive by <u>07:30</u> am to complete all the security procedures.

Accredited media will be escorted to designated areas within the Plenary Hall.

Photographing and video recording is only permitted from the areas allocated to the media within the Plenary Hall.

 Due to limited space and security issues we will request that participating <u>media</u> <u>coordinate for pooled coverage</u>. IFAD can provide professional footage of any portion of the event/s to media when requested.

Filming is not permitted in general areas such as the cafeteria or staff offices.

It is not permitted to film and/or photograph security officers and systems.

T Those media outlets that plan to photograph/film delegates entering and departing must do so in the Plenary Hall and not by the entrance at Via Paolo Di Dono 44.

TV camera crews must remain in designated areas in the Plenary Hall at all times when the meetings are in session.

Media outlets who accompany the dignitaries must follow all the media related guidelines stated above.
