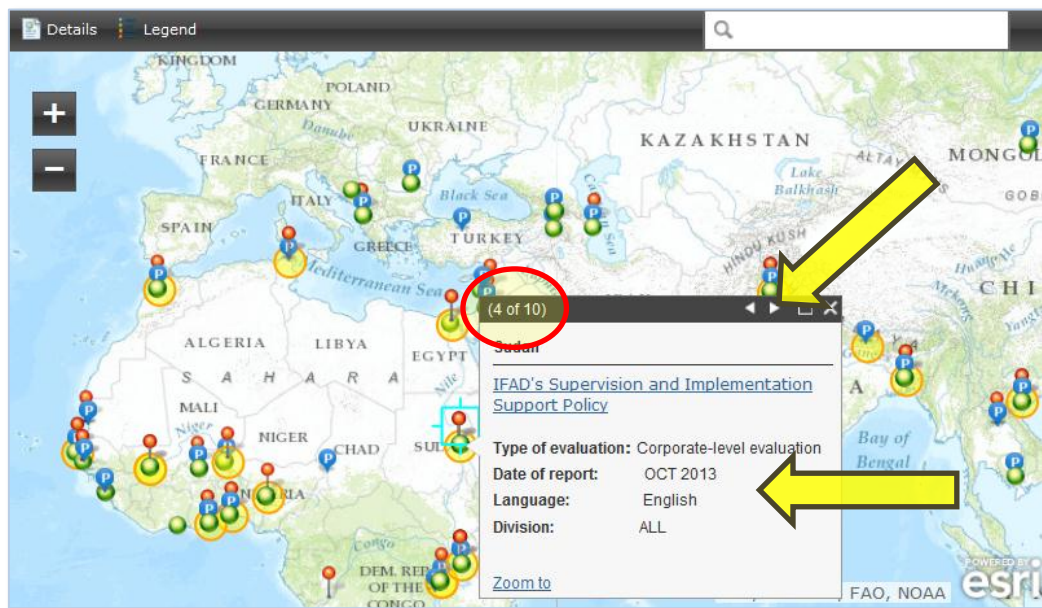
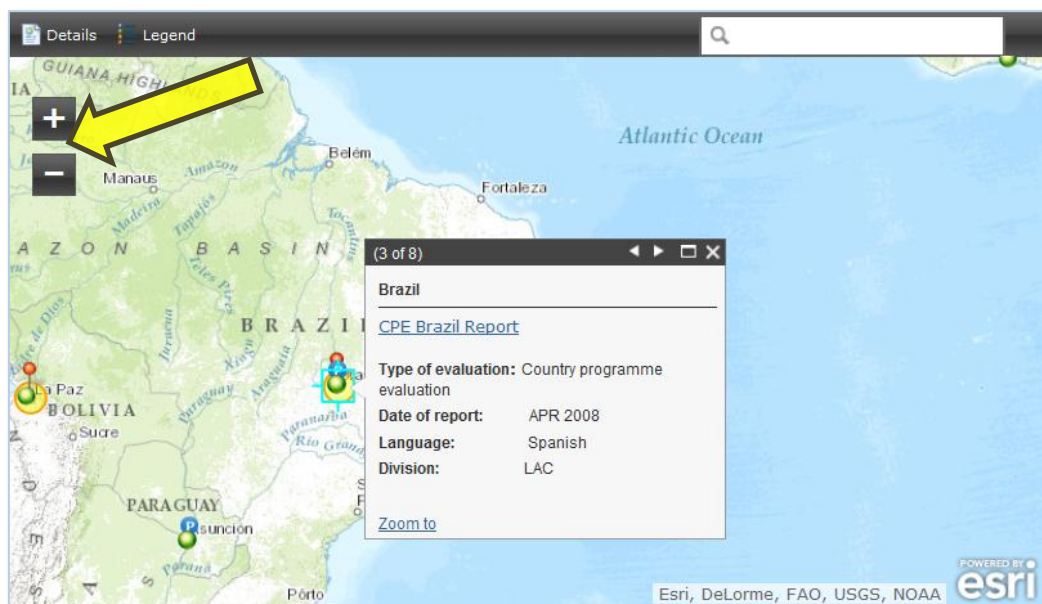


Interactive map tutorial

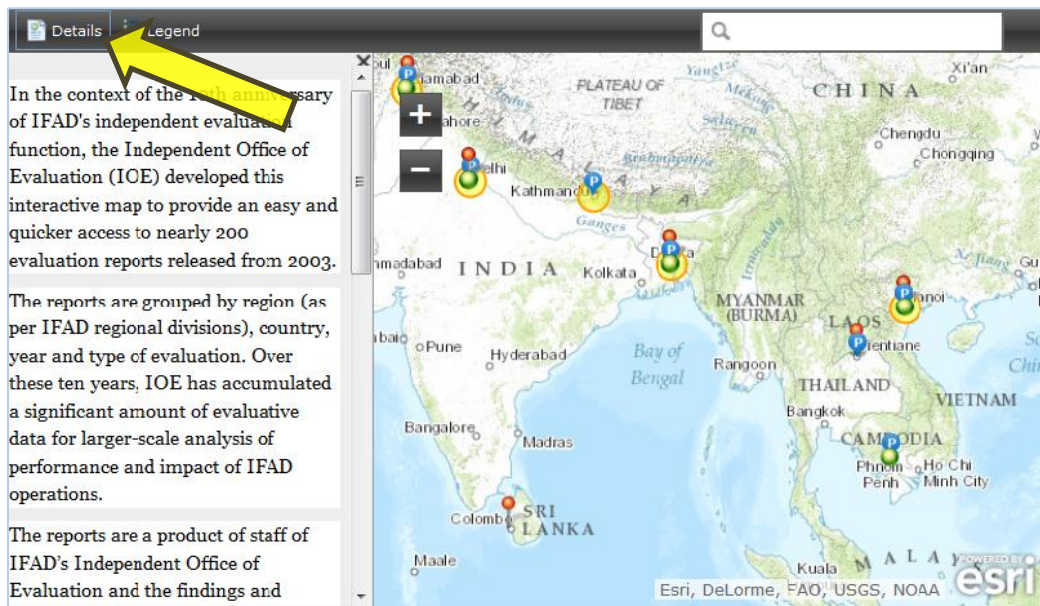
1. Open the map in full screen, selecting the “[View Larger Map](#)” option. A planisphere will be displayed, featuring four different symbols. By **clicking once** on each symbol, a small window will pop-up, showing which reports were published on a specific country. To browse all reports, click on the small white arrows in the black toolbar on the top. You will see that the data displayed in parenthesis (i.e. 1 of 10, 2 of 10, and so forth) designate the total number of published reports. The text in blue shows the [report's title](#) and it directly leads to the specific report's web page. Further information about the type of evaluation, date of report, language and IFAD division is showed.



2. To **zoom** in and out, use the buttons on the left or just **double click** on the map.



3. By clicking once on “**Details**”, you can access background information on the map. To hide this information, click on the “x” on the right.



4. By clicking once on “**Legend**”, you can learn about the symbols related to each report (corporate-level evaluation, country programme evaluation, evaluation synthesis and project evaluation). To hide this information, click on the “x” on the right.
