






San Pedro Jicayán is an indian Mixtec village remotely located, near the town of Pinotepa Nacional

Distance does not means isolation






"Legitimate rights" of the people

- The glyphs mark the dominant points of the borders of the territory.
- The ruler is seated in his palace, upon the combination of day
 (9 Snake) and year
 (10 Deer) which allows to date the document.
- Under custody of the Agrarian Authority of the village.
- Officially recognized as a proof of the legitimate rights of the people of San Pedro Jicayán upon their "Communal lands".

Agriculture and individual possession



Main crops: corn (maize), frijol (bean), chile, courge

- Surface of the municipality: 85 km²
- Surface parcelada (individual possession): 8305 has
- Surface of urban settlements: 2019 has
- Beneficiaries (comuneros): 1902
- Most plots: ¼ hectare- 5 hectares, some comuneros: up to 20 or 30 hectares.

Agriculture is mainly on hill lands, with a hardened stick and machete. The narrow margins of the rivers may be tilled with plow. It is a great advantage to possess even small pieces of these tierras de riego (irrigated lands).


