Introduction

The International Conference on "Investing in inclusive rural transformation: Innovative approaches to financing" will take place in Rome, Italy, from 25-27 January 2017.

Airports – Two main airports serve Rome, Leonardo da Vinci (Fiumicino) airport and Ciampino airport. Fiumicino airport is 36 km west of Rome and Ciampino airport is 16 km southwest of Rome. A train runs between Fiumicino and Termini station (near Rome's historic centre), while Terravision shuttle buses connect Ciampino airport to Termini Station. There is no direct rail link to the city centre from Ciampino airport.

Metro (underground) – IFAD headquarters is a 15-minute walk from Laurentina Metro station in the area of Rome known as EUR. The station is the last stop on Line B, which connects to Rome's historic city centre. The station also serves as a bus terminal.

Tickets for public transportation can be bought at vending machines in metro stations, at tobacco shops and newspaper kiosks. They are valid for 75 minutes, which includes one trip on the Metro and/or unlimited bus travel. Tickets must be validated immediately upon boarding the bus or tram.

Taxis – Taxis may be requested at the main guard house (extension 2300). Taxis can also be booked directly by calling +39 06 3570. Please note, that any taxi called but not used is entitled to payment of a minimum fare. From 1.00 to 5.00, women wishing to travel by a dedicated night-time taxi service for women can dial +39 06 35701 in order to be connected to an operator who will transfer the call to Lady Cab, at no additional cost.

Information and services

Shuttle bus – A shuttle bus service is available from 7.40 to 9.25 between Laurentina Metro station and IFAD headquarters and from 16.45 to 18.50 from IFAD headquarters back to Laurentina Metro station. The pick-up and drop-off point at the Laurentina metro is Viale Luca Gaurico, 9-11, on the main road behind the station. The IFAD drop-off and pick-up point is the yellow bus stop adjacent to the main entrance of the guardhouse (between 50 and 44 Via Paolo di Dono).

To accommodate the reception hosted in IFAD, the evening shuttle bus departing from IFAD on 26 January, will run until 21.35.




Logistical information


