Introduction

Farmers hold the solutions to combat climate change. No other economic sector is impacted by the effects of the changing climate more than agriculture, but no other economic actor worldwide can do as much as farmers can to fight climate change.

The Climakers is a Farmers Driven Climate Change Agenda that proposes a reversed approach in fighting climate change where farmers drive the solutions to tackle climate change.

The Climakers Agenda is based on the promotion of best practices that farmers are already implementing as practical solutions to mitigate and adapt to the climate change. These best practices that are collected though an authentic bottom up approach from the farmers will be proposed to the Governments with practical guidance on how to include them in the National Determined Contribution, NDCs, for the implementation of Paris Agreement, to be scaled up or replicated in different areas.

The proposed solutions are scientifically assessed by the Climate Change, Food Security and Agriculture, CCAFS, programme of the CGIAR.

Farmers deserve to be at the center of the decision-making process on agriculture, at local, national and international levels, and they are ready and willing to fulfil this critical role. However, farmers also rely on the political, technical and financial support of other stakeholders in the agricultural

sector. To this extent, the Climakers foresees a global alliance of Farmers' Organizations first and then with other members of the sector.

The Farmers Driven Climate Change Agenda is very ambitious, and its success depends on the Climakers Alliance.

Conceived in the framework of the FAFO, as a gathering of Farmers, WFO event will bring together farmers representatives of the Climakers' Alliance carrying their own experience in the initiative and in the fight against climate change.
