The role of the public sector in the assimilation process of innovative agrotechnologies: The Israeli model

ODED FORER

Minister, Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development of Israel



Oded Forer is the Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development of Israel and the Minister for the Development of the Periphery, the Negev, and the Galilee. Previously Minister Forer served as a member of Knesset on behalf of the Israel Beiteinu party and as the chairman of the Finance Committee and the Committee for the Advancement of Women and Gender Equality in the Knesset, and worked to legislate and promote the fight against domestic violence. Minister Forer also chaired the Knesset's Small and Medium Business Lobby. In 2013, he was appointed as the Director-General of Israel's Ministry of Immigrant Absorption where he successfully initiated a special plan to absorb immigrants from France and led the government initiative for a national programme to promote the integration of Ethiopian immigrants. Minister Forer was the founder and Director-General of CEO Strategy, an organizational development company that serves as a consultant to various Public-Private Partnership projects (PPP). He also served as Captain in the Israel Defence Forces Navy Reserves as Commanding Officer of 6 "Dabur" boat patrol unit,

and as training officer at the naval academy. He is an advocate by profession and holds a bachelor's degree (B.A) in government and an LL.B in Law from IDC and an M.A. in political communication from Tel Aviv University. Minister Forer is married and has three daughters.

DOMINIK ZILLER

Vice-President, IFAD



Dominik Ziller is Vice-President of IFAD. He gives strategic direction to the institution, and promotes corporate approaches and solutions. He has direct oversight of the budget, quality assurance and ethics offices. Prior to joining IFAD, Ziller was Director General for International Development Cooperation for International Development Policy at the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development. His responsibilities included the European Union's development cooperation, United Nations, World Bank Group, regional development banks, OECD, development processes of the G7 and the G20, the World Trade Organization and topics of financing for development and effectiveness/transparency. During Germany's G20 Presidency, Ziller chaired the Development Working Group. Previously, he held various senior positions at the BMZ, including head of the Directorate for Asia and head of the

Budget Division. Between 2011 and 2013, he worked for Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusam-menarbeit (GIZ), where he was a member of the Executive Management Committee. He holds a Law Degree from the Ludwig Maximilian Universität München and Practical Law Degree from the Federal German State of Bavaria.

YAKOV POLEG

Senior Deputy Director General and Head of the Centre for Foreign Trade and International Cooperation (CFTIC), Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD), Israel



Yakov Poleg is Senior Deputy Director General and Head of the Centre for Foreign Trade and International Cooperation (CFTIC) at Israel's Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD).

Prior to that, he was Head of the Centre for International Agricultural Development Cooperation (CINADCO) at MARD; served for three years (2006-2009) as the Agricultural and Scientific Attaché at the Israeli Embassy in Washington, D.C., and was appointed as the Ministry's representative to the World Trade Organization (WTO), representing Israel agricultural policy at the WTO negotiations on agreements on agriculture. He holds a LL. B Law Bachelor, from the Netanya Academic College (member of the Israeli Bar Association); an M.A in Public Policy, The Open University of Israel; and a B.TEC (Science), from

the South London College. In addition to his position at MARD, he is the Chairman of the Israeli Honey Production Board.
