

Digital Agriculture in Asia and the Pacific:Strategies for Donor Impact

Concept

Background. Over the last two decades, mobile and smartphone ownership and mobile coverage in rural Asia have increased steadily. As a result, farmers and agribusinesses are increasingly able to use digital technologies to address the challenges that they face, including limited access to markets. There are systemic challenges, however, that are in need of public sector and donor support, particularly to drive positive outcomes for smallholder farmers.

The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) has commissioned a report by Grow Asia which illustrates how digital technologies are reshaping agriculture in the region and highlights how IFAD's strategic investment decisions could shape and accelerate the adoption of technologies to fulfil IFAD's mission to "transform rural economies and food systems by making them more inclusive, productive, resilient and sustainable". The report describes the two waves of digital agriculture innovation that Grow Asia has observed in ASEAN smallholder value chains - the Farm Mobile Communication and Agribusiness Digitization Waves, and explores the barriers, levers and ways that IFAD and other donors could use to accelerate the uptake of digital agriculture technologies.

Purpose of the Event. The *Digital Agriculture in Asia and the Pacific: Strategies for Donor Impact* webinar is being organized to share the report as well as to spark conversations with different donors such as the **Asian Development Bank (ADB)**, the **Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT)** and IFAD on how donor funding could be strategically deployed to shape and accelerate the adoption of digital agriculture technologies, for greater impact on the most vulnerable rural communities.

ADB, DFAT and IFAD colleagues will share their experiences with digital agriculture in Asia, including comments on the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on the acceleration (or not) of digital agriculture tools.
