

The Fund for Innovation in Development (FID), chaired by Professor Esther Duflo and hosted at the Agence Française de Développement, was launched early 2021 to offer a new ground for the experimentation of the most innovative and impactful solutions in the fight against poverty and inequalities. It brings together innovative solutions providers, researchers and policy-makers to pilot new solutions, rigorously validate their potential impact, help them rapidly scale up based on existing evidence and transform public policies.

Two years after its creation, FID has built a strong portfolio of more than 50 projects across thematic areas including rural development solutions. FID wishes to share and discuss the first lessons learned from funding evidence-based innovative solutions from early stage prototypes to wider scale impact evaluations. We will discuss with team leaders and researchers involved in rural development projects supported by FID on the specific dynamics at the intersect of innovation and impact evaluation.
