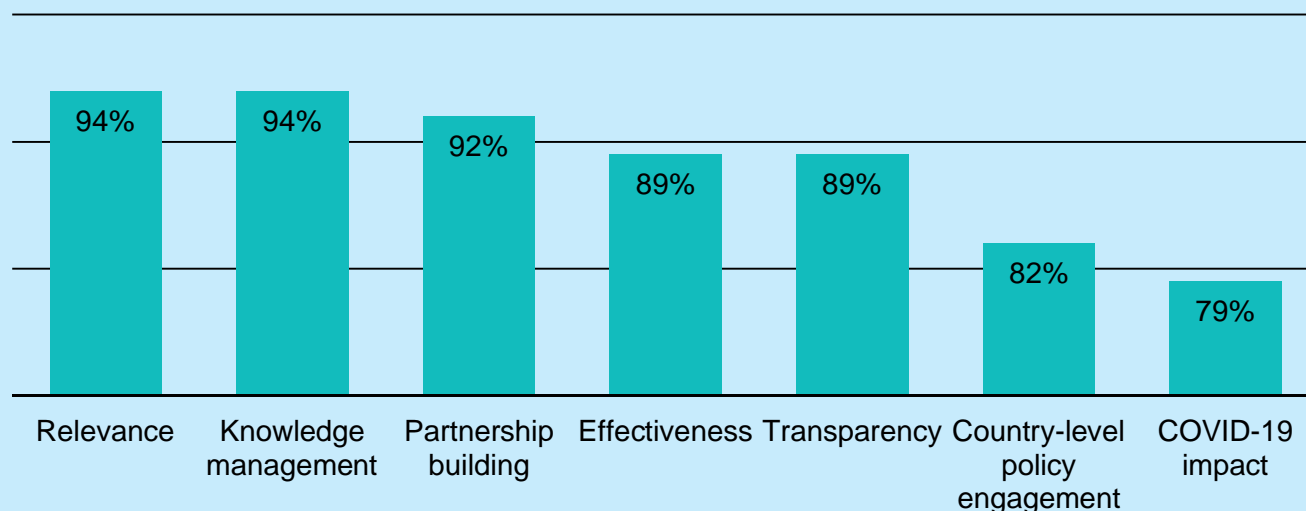

Percentage of favourable scores (3 or 4) by performance dimension¹

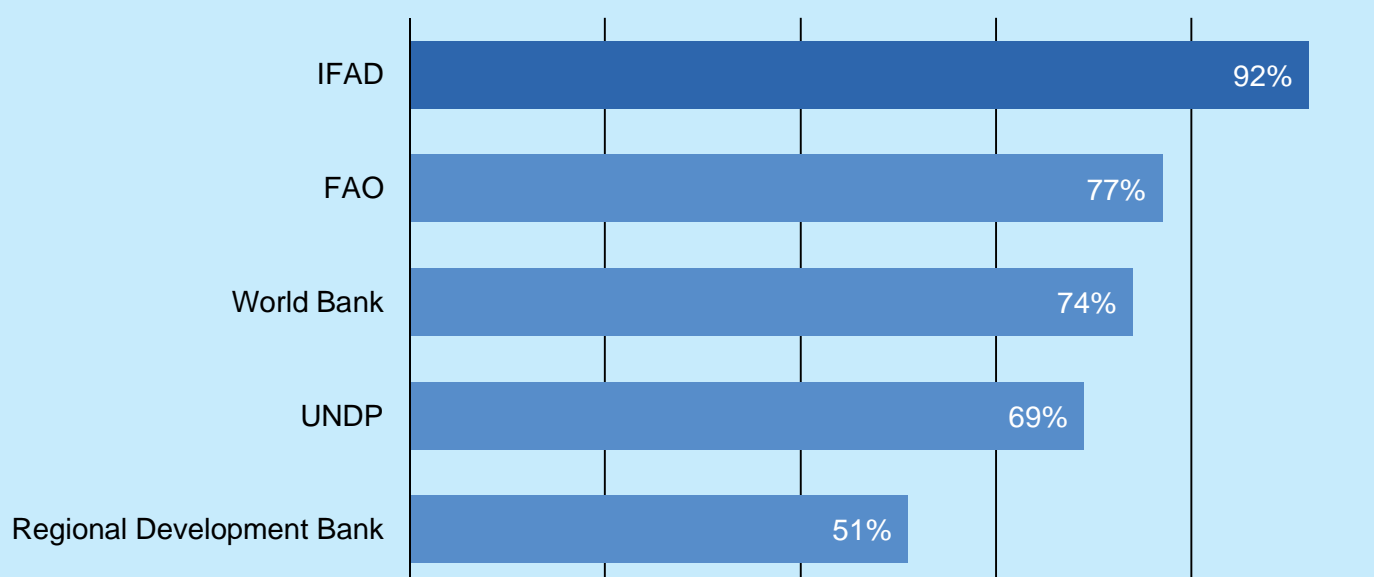

Ways IFAD can improve delivery of its mandate on Sustainable Development Goals 1 and 2

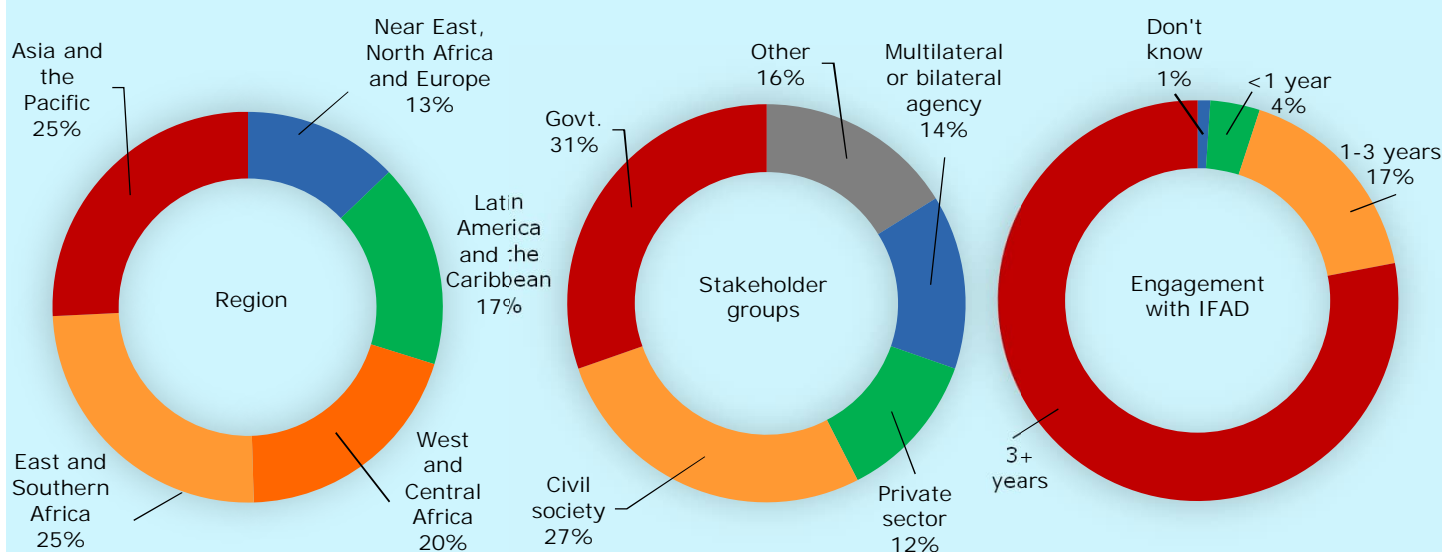
What is the most important thing that IFAD should do in the future to strengthen its efforts to reduce rural poverty and food insecurity in your country?²

1. Greater capacity development for **smallholder farmers** and **small and medium-sized enterprises** (20%)
2. Increase **cofinancing** of programmes with domestic and international partners (20%)
3. Mobilise new **private sector investment** and **public-private partnerships (PPPs)** (15%)
4. Strengthen existing **public-private-producer partnerships** to be more effective (9%)
5. Better **target IFAD's country programming** to benefit the most vulnerable groups (8%)
6. Make it easier to access IFAD's **technical assistance** and **advisory products** (7%)
7. More active engagement within **national policy dialogues** on rural poverty (6%)
8. Support leaders to effectively implement, monitor, and assess **existing policies** (3%)
9. Increase **exchanges** and **South-South and triangular cooperation (SSTC) opportunities** (3%)
10. Increase the quality or relevance of IFAD's **experts and knowledge products** (2%)
11. Increase technical assistance to leaders to design or formulate **new policies** (2%)

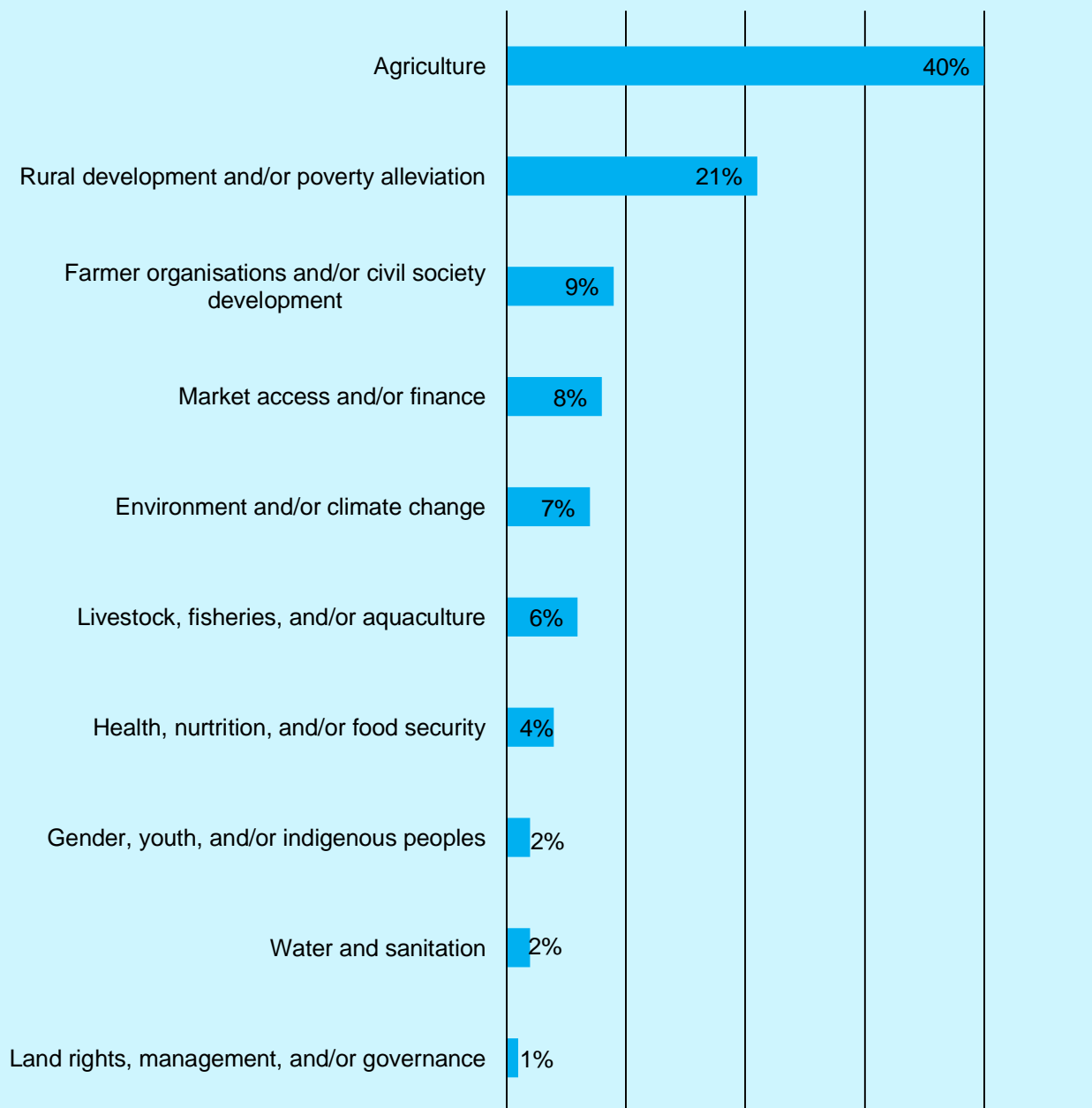
Participants in the 2022 IFAD Stakeholder Survey
